INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PVC STRIP CURTAINS – FACE FIXED

1. Tools Required

Measuring tape Spirit level Cutting knife Square Scriber

2. Preparation

- Check construction, soundness and level/plumbness of door frame and jamb.
- Check opening measurements match curtain dimensions

NB: Face fixed curtains are designed to overlap door opening. The PVC strips are fitted onto bolts which slot into header rail

- Check lengths of PVC strip provided to determine correct fixing height for header.
- Ensure bottom of strip clears floor by 10mm (for pedestrian use) or 20mm (for forklift use)

3. Install The Header Rail

- After determining header rail height, install header rail horizontally and evenly above door opening – Check with level.
- Fit bolts provided inside header channel, sliding all bolts in from one end.

4. Install the PVC Strip

- AceDoors PVC strip is available in following sizes:
 - o 100mm x 2mm
 - o 200mm x 2mm
 - o 300mm x 3mm
- Each strip is pre-punched to suit bolts and to give either 30% or 60% strip overlap. NB: AceDoors recommends 60% overlap for maximum hygiene and insect repellent efficiency.
- The PVC strips are slightly convex. The drawing below shows how they fit and interlock.



- Fit outside strip as shown above, with convex edge of strip turning in towards edge of doorway for tighter seal. Adjacent second strip is reversed to interlock.
- Fasten first strip (strip 1) flush with one end of header rail, using PVC strip washer and nut. Gently stretch strip.

 Repeat with remaining strips in following order, noting that last bolt hole in one strip overlaps first hole of adjacent strip:

Strip 3

- Go back and hang Strip 2, place washers and nuts, stretch and lightly tighten. Strip 5
- Go back and hang Strip 4, place washers and nuts, stretch and lightly tighten.
- When all strips are in place, pull strips across from one side to other to make them taut and tighten nuts.
- Check to ensure that bottom of the strips clear the floor by correct distance. Trim bottom of strips if necessary.

NB: PVC strips may take short period of use to hang true and may stretch over time. If this occurs, re-trim as necessary to ensure correct clearance to floor.

5. Final Service Delivery Checks

- Ensure all fixings are tightened
- Ensure strip curtain does not touch the floor
- Ensure door arms move and return freely
- Ensure premises left in clean and secure condition

Client to be asked to observe PVC strip installation and operation for acceptance.
